An adequate fire line shall be made around the area to be burned and a force of adults, sufficient to control the fire, shall be on hand at the time of burning. Name of person on this permit shall be liable for all damage to property which may result from burning done under this permit.

**ISSUED BY AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF CHESTER TWP. F.D.**

**YOU HAVE A RESPONSIBILITY UNDER THE LAW. READ BELOW**

Act 329, P.A. 1969, as amended, provides that:

1. You must have a permit to have an open fire except when the ground is snow covered, or for domestic purposes, or to protect persons or property in case of fire.
2. Any person who set a fire without taking reasonable precautions to prevent the escape thereof or leaves the fire before it is extinguished is guilty of a misdemeanor.
3. Any person who maliciously sets a fire which endangers human life or destroys the property of another, may upon conviction be assessed a fine of not more than \$10,000 or imprisonment for a term of not over 10 years or both such fine and imprisonment.
4. Any person who negligently allows a fire to escape is liable for all expenses incurred by the State of Michigan in the suppression of such fire.
5. Any permit issued may be revoked if conditions are such that burning may not be done safely.
6. This permit does not supersede any other Act or Ordinance which further restricts or prohibits the setting of fires.
